DAY 1 - LOS ANGELES

December 2

We meet today at 4pm at our accommodation, for a briefing on the adventures to come. We include a workshop (mixed Darran and Julieanne) to maximise your photo interests for the tour. Option to join your guides for dinner tonight.

DAY 2 - LOS ANGELES TO DEATH VALLEY December 3

We depart LA early, driving over the famed Sierra Nevada mountains. The drive is about 5 hours without stops. However, we may stop opportunistically today. Beautiful forests give way to alpine country and eventually to desert.

What a diverse day! We make our way to one of the most unique landscapes on earth - Death Valley. We book into our accommodation and head out for a sunset shoot. The light offers fantastic visual patterns and your tutor team are keen to help you maximise this. After dinner, a workshop by Julieanne on creative concepts. Accommodation: Hotel

DAYS 3/4/5 - DEATH VALLEY

December 4/5/6

Three full days exploring the wonderful and weird landscapes of Death Valley. We target light that suits each location that we will visit. From glorious sand dunes in the morning, to towering peaks, the best landscape photo opportunities. Early starts - workshops - siesta - late light shoots are the order. We will also look at astro shoots, depending on the weather.

We return to some key locations more than once. We will switch time of day for different light. What a special place to explore - the lowest location in the USA - at 282 feet below sea level, Badwater Basin is a surreal landscape that tricks the senses. The stark space and unearthly vistas will amaze you!

We add in a couple of more workshops with Julieanne and the WPA team. These workshops will help you with concepts, visualisation and the best processing. Julieanne will offer you simple but very effective processing techniques. Plus, she will offer the rare chance to enjoy some one-on-one time. Accommodation: Hotel

DAY 6 - DEATH VALLEY TO LAS VEGAS - TOUR ENDS December 7

Morning shoot to target a final key location. We then depart, driving about 3 hours to Las Vegas, with opportunistic stops. We arrive about mid-day and the end of the tour. Services end here, or you can link up with our next amazing adventure. Again, Julieanne joins us!

No meals are included for this tour. This will offer you flexibility of choice and best timing for shoots. The WPA tour leader will help optimise meals for the group. Itinerary and price is subject to change.

PRE TOUR

Accommodation, and services start for this tour - DAY 1. All services before this are not included. We suggest that you arrive at the start point at least 48 hours before this tour begins. This timing will give you a chance to relax and acclimatise to the new time zone. We generally commence booking pre/post tour accommodation/flights about 8/9 months before departure. We will confirm this with you as your guides need to book before you book.

NOTE: This itinerary is flexible to allow your guides to maximise your photo and travel interests to weather and unique opportunities. Specific targeted subjects will be offered the night before departure each day. This will offer you 'the best of the region'. Meals not included in the itinerary, are organised to 'fit in' with the days shoots.

FINAL ITINERARY

Note that a final itinerary will be sent to you about one month before departure.

IMPORTANT

To make sure you book the correct dates and times, we would request the following:

1. Don't purchase any air tickets, until our guides flights have been booked, which we will do approximately 8 - 9 months prior to the tour departure. We will advise you when the guides flights are booked and you can then use this itinerary, to help you use points or similar. This will also coincide with confirming the tour departure, making sure we have met minimum passenger numbers for the tour and the logistics of the tour have not changed. 2. We suggest you arrive a minimum of 24 hours prior to the tour departure - even 48 hours - to help with jet lag and in case of airline delays.
