ACCOMMODATION

All accommodation is included from DAY 1, starting at Kununurra.

TRANSPORT

Land transport for this event is included. We will book large 4WD's, with 3-4 per vehicle. They offer the perfect space for one suitcase and your camera gear. We do not undertake any off road driving. Transport is based on our tried and true system of vehicle pooling and self driving, using 4WD hire vehicles booked by us as a travel operator. You do not need to drive if you do not want to. The key reason for self drive, is to allow us to start early and finish late for the best light. This flexibility also offers you a better price and the chance to meet new friends.

MEALS

Most meals are included as per itinerary.

DAY 1 - WORKSHOP STARTS IN KUNUNURRA TODAY

May 4

We include accommodation tonight in Kununurra. We meet at 4pm for a workshop and a chance to ask questions. This is followed by dinner. Final information will be supplied in our final itinerary, about a month before departure. Accommodation - D.

DAY 2 - KUNUNURRA TO PURNULULU (Bungle Bungle) May 5

We depart early and drive to Purnululu NP (drive time - 4 hr 30 min (328.6 km) via National Highway 1). We will take a little longer with a couple of stops to enjoy the spectacular scenery. Later this afternoon, we drive to our first landscape shoot. Purnululu is in Darran's top handful of incredible photo hot spots worldwide!

Note that photographers of any level are welcome and helped. Our past groups have loved the quality time and unique locations offered by your professional photo guides. They use their experience to maximise timing and show you image options that most would miss. We include our first late light shoot at the domes, often just by ourselves in an incredible wilderness location. Cont....

Our accommodation is glamping, with very comfortable (regular) beds and a great camp atmosphere. It even offers a bar, and your cabin/safari tent offers full en-suite facilities! Wilderness lodging - (D)

DAYs 3/4/5/6 - PURNULULU (Bungle Bungle) May 6/7/8/9

Four full days of visiting all the highlights of this park. Some are so good that we will visit twice. We will be up before sunrise, offer a midday break and back after sunset. Cathedral Cave, Piccininni Gorge, Echidna Chasm and the many other points that add up to new angles and opportunities to make great images.

Plus, we include a 45-minute doors-off helicopter flight over the domes. This flight offers stunning new photos and an eagle-eye view of the vast landscape.

Plus we include astro shoots. Beginners to advanced will find these shoots incredible, with the results being unique and simply - awesome!

Piccininni Gorge: is the iconic domes area of the park. It is surreal, with rock shapes and patterns that are millions of years in the making. We have unique locations and timing and often shoot just by ourselves. This location is so special that we will explore it multiple times in different lighting, including at night.

Cathedral Cave: What a stunning amphitheatre! The walk-in also offers great landscape images and, occasionally, a wildlife surprise.

Echidna Chasm: Australia's premier chasm is a creative photographer's dream. We target the best time and spend quality time aiming for that unique result.

Nature: But it is not about landscapes only. We can photograph birds, reptiles and other fascinating creatures.

We include workshops with an emphasis on workshops in the field. (One 45-minute Helicopter trip is included.) Wilderness lodging - (B,D)



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DAY 7 - PURNULULU TO KUNUNURRA

May 10

After another great morning shoot at the domes, we load up our exclusive 4WD vehicles and drive back to Kununurra. Again, expect a stop or two for new subjects to photograph on the way.

We arrive back to Kununurra in the afternoon. Our last group dinner allows us to tell a few tall stories. Accommodation - (B,D)

The workshop is over. You can depart as required.

PRE TOUR

Accommodation, and services start for this event - DAY 1 meeting at Kununurra. All travel services before this are not included. We suggest that you arrive at the start point at least 24 hours before this event begins. This timing will give you a chance to relax and acclimatise to the new time zone. We generally commence booking pre/post tour accommodation/flights about 5/6 months before departure.

NOTE: This itinerary is flexible to allow your guides to maximise your photo and travel interests to weather and unique opportunities. Specific targeted subjects will be offered the night before departure each day. This will offer you 'the best of the region'. Meals not included in the itinerary, are organised to 'fit in' with the days shoots.

WALKS AND CONDITIONS

The Kimberley is rugged, warm to hot and predominately dry with rocky uneven walks. However, we are not in a rush, taking our time to enjoy the natural beauty offered by one of the world's great wilderness locations. The walks are not long with most about 1-2km's. It is rare a walker will find the walks difficult.

HELICOPTERS

Please note that you should not book any helicopter services during the workshop. This facet of the adventure needs to be co-ordinated by Darran to allow for the event logistics, best time and to optimise prices for the group. WPA will not receive a commission.

TRANSPORT

Land transport for this event is included. We will book large 4WD's, with 3-4 per vehicle. They offer the perfect space for one suitcase and your camera gear. We do not undertake any off road driving. Transport is based on our tried and true system of vehicle pooling and self driving, using 4WD hire vehicles booked by us as a travel operator. You do not need to drive if you do not want to. The key reason for self drive, is to allow us to start early and finish late for the best light. This flexibility also offers you a better price and the chance to meet new friends. We rotate vehicles to suit.

FINAL ITINERARY

Note that a final itinerary will be sent to you about one month before departure.

IMPORTANT

To make sure you book the correct dates and times, we would request the following:

1. Don't purchase any air tickets, until our guides flights have been booked, which we will do approximately 5/6 months prior to the tour departure. We will advise you when the guides flights are booked and you can then use this itinerary, to help you use points or similar. This will also coincide with confirming the tour departure, making sure we have met minimum passenger numbers for the tour and the logistics of the tour have not changed.

2. We suggest you arrive a minimum of 24 hours prior to the tour departure - even 48 hours - to help with jet lag and in case of airline delays.

SKILL/FITNESS LEVELS - WALKS

This workshop is open to all photo skill levels. We are not undertaking long walks, instead offering shorter walks with quality time to shoot, learn and explore. However, please take note that rocks and uneven ground can create awkward/slippery moments on any walk. Your guides will offer the best up to date information for each walk, but common sense also needs to prevail. It is your responsibility to take care on all walks. If uncomfortable or if you need help, please let your guide know.

SICKNESS WHILE TRAVELLING

Viruses, bacteria and other health risks have always been possible when travelling. We select accommodation and operators to limit risk to your health.

Before departure, we suggest that you consider limiting your exposure to large groups and other high risk location/situations at least 7 days before departure.

Please bring face masks, and hand sanitizer. Should you feel unwell during the event, please let your tour leader know ASAP.
