ACCOMMODATION

All accommodation is included from DAY 1 in Lodges and Resorts.

TRANSPORT

Land transport for this event is included. We will book large 4WD's, with 3-4 per vehicle. They offer the perfect space for one suitcase and your camera gear. We do not undertake any off road driving. Transport is based on our tried and true system of vehicle pooling and self driving, using 4WD hire vehicles booked by us as a travel operator. You do not need to drive if you do not want to. The key reason for self drive, is to allow us to start early and finish late for the best light. This flexibility also offers you a better price and the chance to meet new friends.

ITINERARY TO ADVENTURE...

DAY 1 - CAIRNS

June 5

We suggest that you have arrived at least one day earlier in Cairns. We start today at 2pm with a workshop that will help you maximise the week of amazing shoots ahead. Learn how to visualise a result before you shoot. It is the key to great results. Welcome to Tropical North Queensland. Accommodation - Cairns Esplanade TBA

DAY 2 - CAIRNS TO LAKE EACHAM (Atherton Tablelands)

June 6

We pick up our 4WD hire vehicles today and depart Cairns at 8am this morning, driving south, and then west to target waterfalls and rainforest. These are not just any waterfalls, but some of the most beautiful in Australia. A full day of moderate walking with an emphasis on learning the best techniques and trying some angles that are new and creative. We arrive at our lodge and overnight late afternoon. Tonight includes unique shoots of rare animals in the wild.

DAY 3 - ATHERTON TABLELANDS REGION

June 7

Our accommodation is a perfect base as it offers stunning shoot opportunities from waterfalls to rainforest and creative images. We target fantastic locations, Darran using his experience for the best rainforest, nature and creative shoots. Platypus are very possible, along with different shaped mushrooms, backlit plants and rare possums and other animals. Some subjects will be just metres from your accommodation! Accommodation - Lodge

DAY 4 - ATHERTON TABLELANDS REGION

June 8

Another full day of photographing birds, nature and exploring photography beyond your current boundaries. We will try new lighting techniques and process some of the results during an in-door workshop. Many subjects are close to your accommodation and some are rare or very uncommon like striped possums, rifle birds, frogs, the list is long. The lodge has a special history of working with nature to show you the best of the region. Accommodation - Lodge

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DAY 5 - ATHERTON TABLELANDS REGION TO PORT DOUGLAS/DAINTREE June 9

Final morning shoot to capture those subjects that have most interested you. Your photo guides will help. After breakfast, we depart with a stop for the tiny Mareeba rock-wallabies. Our journey continues across the Atherton Tablelands, dropping down to the coast and to beautiful Port Douglas where we are based for the next 2 nights. Accommodation - Port Douglas TBA

DAY 6 - PORT DOUGLAS/DAINTREE

June 10

Early morning exclusive cruise on the Daintree River. This is a fantastic experience with kingfishers, crocodiles and other nature subjects, sometimes up close. We add another workshop and finish the day with another Daintree River cruise. Different light, warmer conditions guarantee new nature images and the chance to be creative. Tonight, we show our favourite 10 images of the week. The diversity is incredible! Accommodation - Port Douglas TBA

DAY 7 - PORT DOUGLAS TO CAIRNS - WORKSHOP ENDS

June 11

Final morning shoot at The Habitat wildlife park. This will offer you animals that you most likely have not seen before. We arrive in Cairns at about 12 noon and the end of the workshop. Note that you should not book any flights until after 3pm as timing can not be guaranteed. You may like to book another nights accommodation?

TRANSPORT

Land transport for this event is included from Day 2 as per itinerary, until you are dropped off either at the airport or at accommodation on the Cairns Esplanade - Day 7. We do not include any other transport services.

MEALS

All meals as per itinerary. We recommend that you carry water and a snack with you at all times.

PRE TOUR

Accommodation, and services start for this event - DAY 1 meeting at Cairns. All travel services before this are not included. We suggest that you arrive at the start point at least 24 hours before this event begins. This timing will give you a chance to relax and acclimatise to the new time zone. We generally commence booking pre/post tour accommodation/flights about 5/6 months before departure.

NOTE: This itinerary is flexible to allow your guides to maximise your photo and travel interests to weather and unique opportunities. Specific targeted subjects will be offered the night before departure each day. This will offer you 'the best of the region'. Meals not included in the itinerary, are organised to 'fit in' with the days shoots.

FINAL ITINERARY

Note that a final itinerary will be sent to you about one month before departure.

IMPORTANT

To make sure you book the correct dates and times, we would request the following:

1. Don't purchase any air tickets, until our guides flights have been booked, which we will do approximately 6-7 months prior to the tour departure. We will advise you when the guides flights are booked and you can then use this itinerary, to help you use points or similar. This will also coincide with confirming the tour departure, making sure we have met minimum passenger numbers for the tour and the logistics of the tour have not changed. 2. We suggest you arrive a minimum of 24 hours prior to the tour departure - even 48 hours - to help with jet lag and in case of airline delays.
